The goal is to help parents/guardians: to guide, teach, listen and support you. Raising children can be challenging, stressful and is a constant balancing act.

Program includes:

- → Topic based workshops through-out winter/spring. Date/workshops TBD.
- → Parenting Mentoring groups offered weekly, day and evening sessions.
- → Individual Parent Consultations to assist with child's emotional, behavioral and learning concerns.
- → Assistance with balancing busy schedules: ways to de-stress, time-management, discipline, creating structure at home and time for yourself.
- → Therapist can collaborate with designated school staff for consultation if needed.
- → Assistance with Resources and Linkage to Services in the Community
